CLUB POLICY

- To encourage and promote the game of Australian Rules Football played by members of the club.
- To promote good fellowship, true sportsmanship and citizenship amongst footballers, coaches, supporters, guardians and parents.
- To provide suitable facilities and promote healthy social lifestyle, recreation, entertainment and amusement to all members.
- Parents who have players in Auskick to Year 6 are requested to stay with their children during training sessions & games or organise a carer.
- All players regardless of gender, size or ability will be given equal game time from Auskick to Year 12.
- All players will play in their correct year groups (refer to Team Allocation Policy)
- Coaches from Auskick to Year 6 will produce a team sheet for all games displaying team rotation for all quarters. All players are to be rotated each quarter. The team sheet is to be produced on request from committee members and parents and guardians
- Players in Years 7 – 12's are to be treated equally and fairly. They all will be entitled to play a minimum of 50% game time with the expectation of equal game time regardless of potential, size, or talent. Coaches are to ensure all players are given equal amount of bench time throughout the season. If this does not eventuate coaches will be asked to explain and may have their accreditation rescinded
- To ensure all coaches at Bullcreek Leeming Junior Football Club are accredited by the AFL.
- To encourage all members to support club officials to foster high standards of behaviour for the club and the district.
- Illicit drug taking will not be tolerated at Bullcreek Leeming Junior Football Club and will incur an immediate suspension

- Remember smoking and the consumption of alcohol is unacceptable at games or training.
- The Club may use photographs and or video of players, coaches, parents, officials and spectators during the promotion of the club. Please advise the club in writing at time of registration if you object to images being used.
- All players from Auskick through to Year 12 are to ensure they wear a mouthguard to training and games. No mouthguard no game. If an injury occurs and no mouthguard is worn you may jeopardise your insurance claim. All parents are to urge their children to wear a mouthguard. This policy is to be Strictly adhered to.
